



Greetings! I am your University Libraries' Liaison Librarian to the Department of Geography. This means that I am your go-to source for anything library related. Below are just a few of the ways I can help:

**Research Consultation Service:** Consultations are available for individual students or faculty as well as for small groups. They are also a great way to help students who are unfamiliar with the library and need extra help getting started on research. During these consultations, librarians can help student or faculty in finding books, journal articles and data sources. They can also cover topics like citation management as well as research data management. There is a [form](#) that can be filled out to request a consultation but you can always just email me.

**Custom Research Guides:** Librarians can create subject or class-specific research guides to aid students in locating library resources as well as other useful sources on the web. [Here](#) is an existing research guide that I created for students majoring in Environmental Studies. I would be more than happy to create a custom guide for a specific research topic or class.

**Research and Publishing:** Our [Scholarly Communications Librarian](#) can help with issues related to copyright and author's rights. He can also assist with publishing in open access journals as well as making articles available in our institutional repository, [DigiNole Commons](#). As the Research Data Librarian, I can help with developing data management plans for grant applications, which has recently become a requirement from many major funding agencies, such as the National Institute of Health. Furthermore, I would be glad to provide assistance and guidance in research data management planning for any research endeavor.

**Instruction Sessions:** Library research instruction is available for any class at your request. These sessions help in reducing library anxiety for students and, most importantly, to let them know that we are here to help. Instruction sessions can be scheduled to provide a general overview of library services and programs. However, like the research guides, we can provide customized instruction sessions for specific classes.

**Library Express Delivery Service (LEDs):** FSU faculty are eligible to use the Library Express Delivery Service (LEDs). This means that you can have library materials sent directly to your office. Circulating materials from all of the libraries on the main campus, including books, media, book chapters, and journal articles qualify for this service. **Ordering Library Materials:** I can also assist you in ordering library materials specific to your department's needs. This includes books, databases, and sometimes datasets. We can work together to select specific titles to add to our collection or a specific dataset that is crucial for a specific project or area of research.
